


- Survey conducted in January/February of 2016


At which location do you spend the most time?




At which grade level do you believe subject level specialization should be implemented? (check all that apply)






Do you feel our students have or will benefit from the multiage instructional strategy?






Have you incorporated Problem-Based Learning into your teaching? (All staff)




Do you feel you have had adequate training on Problem-Based Learning? (All staff)




Do you feel our students have or will benefit from Problem-Based Learning? (All staff)




What advice would you give in terms of continuing to use the Problem-Based Learning teaching strategy? (All staff)




Are you teaching in a Looping class? (All staff)




Do you feel you have had adequate training on the Looping concept?




Do you feel our students have or will benefit from Looping?




What advice would you give in terms of continuing the FLES program?
