

Physical Examination and Immunizations:

Glen Ellyn School District 41 policy requires a child entering kindergarten or 6th grade or NEW to District 41 have a current State of Illinois school physical and updated immunization record on file **PRIOR to the first day of school in order to avoid exclusion.**

New Students who register for school AFTER the first day of school of that current school year have 30 calendar days to provide the health office with a current State of Illinois school physical and proof of immunizations in order to avoid exclusion.

Eye Exam:

An updated professional eye exam is required for students enrolling in Kindergarten or for students (grades 1- 8) who are new to an Illinois school for the first time. These are due by October 15th of that current school year or 30 days after initial enrollment if starting after October 15th of that current school year.

Dental Exam:

Students entering kindergarten, second and sixth grade are required to have a dental exam completed by May 15th of that current school year. The dental exam must have been performed within the last 18 months of May 15th of that current school year.

If you are experiencing difficulty obtaining medical care for your child or have any questions or concerns, please contact your school nurse.

Completed physical forms should be turned in to the appropriate school health office as soon as they are completed.
